# Brøndby Cup 2009



Again in 2009 Brøndby IF welcomes you to an extensive international youth football tournament. Over the years boys and girls from all over the world have visited Brøndby and taken part in Brøndby Cup thereby gaining memorable experiences on and off the pitch. In later years autograph sessions, meeting high profile players from Brøndby's Mens-League and Womens-League teams, a football experience at Brøndby Stadium, computer games at Brøndby Kids' lounge and trips to Copenhagen city centre have been among the most popular activities.

Should Brøndby IF play a League home match during Brøndby Cup 2009, all Brøndby Cup participants will of course get access to Brøndby Stadium.

Teams participating in Brøndby Cup 2009 will be divided into level A and B hereby securing even and fair matches.

## The Tournament

### Tournament rules

The tournament will take place at Brøndby Stadium which consists of 19 very well prepared pitches. This means that all matches will be played in the same area creating an intense atmosphere (without interruptions due to travel between pitches).

Accommodation is offered at local schools. For the most part in walking distance from the stadium. Free shuttle busses will be available for those staying a little further away. Check-in opens on Saturday August 1 at 10.00 am. Latest check-out is Friday August 7 in the morning.

### First round

Teams are divided into groups of at least 4 teams each, and all teams play against each other. These matches will be played on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday.

### Finals

Playoff is played for all rankings meaning that all teams play a number of matches against teams at roughly the same level. Playoff will be played on Wednesday and Thursday

**Both level A and B teams play full time finals in accordance with danish regulations.**

Players who meet the required ages may participate in two age classifications.

***Age dispensation will be given for up to 3 players per squad. However, only 2 age dispensations will be given to teams in 7 player tournaments. Dispensations must be applied for no later than July 1, 2009.*** Once the tournament is running, further dispensation will not be given.

All Brøndby Cup players must present valid id on request.

In 11 player tournaments there is a maximum of 16 players per match, whereas 7 player tournaments may have an unlimited number of players.

## Team and participant fees

Upon registration each playing team pays a team fee plus a fee per participant.

Fee per participant is paid for all players, coaches and team leaders with the exception of 2 coaches/team leaders per team.

Enrolment is binding and will not be registered until payment for participant fee has been received

**Deadline for Brøndby Cup registration is May 15, 2009.**

*Participant fee is due by June 1, 2009.*

Team fee: £gbp 250 per team

Participant fee per player: £gbp 125 per person

Additional night: £gbp 7

Meals only (no accomodation): £gbp 80

**When a team has played its final match, a 500 DKK (£gbp 60) team fee refund will be given.**

Teams that do not require accomodation pay team fee only.

## Participant fee includes:

- Brøndby Cup participation

- Free entrance at Brøndby Stadium if Brøndbys League team plays a League match during the Cup
- Admission to **Cup disco**
- 1 t-shirt per Brøndby Cup participant
- 1 football per team signed by Brøndby IF's **Mens-League players**
- 2 tickets per club for the managers' meeting. Additional tickets can be purchased

In accordance with local danish regulations finals are full time matches.

If 2 or more teams end up with the same number of points, tiebreakers are used: 1. Goal difference. 2. Total goals scored. 3. Head-to-head results. 4. Penalty shootouts.

### **Boys Elite Tournament (11 player tournament)**

Classification E01 (U15) boys born after 1.1.1995	2 x 35 min.
Classification E02 (U14) boys born after 1.1.1996	2 x 35 min.
Classification E03 (U13) boys born after 1.1.1997	2 x 30 min.

Elite tournament teams play only one full time match per day. Matches are played in the afternoon allowing you to practise in the morning.

All matches in the Elite tournament will be refereed by a referee and two assistants.

Teams participating in the Elite tournament must be ranked in the respective country's top 5. If not, teams are subject to approval by the tournament committee.
